8/29/05 HAVING REVIEWED THE MATTER, THE COURT FINDS AND ORDERS AS
FOLLOWS:

1. THE ISSUES TO BE RAISED IN R.K.H. AND K.A.B.'S MOTION TO
ACCEPT JURISDICTION OVER INTERLOCUTORY APPEAL FILED IN APPEAL I
INVOLVE SUBSTANTIAL QUESTIONS OF LAW, THE EARLY DETERMINATION OF
WHICH WOULD PROMOTE A MORE ORDERLY DISPOSITION OF THE CASE.
ALSO, R.K.H. AND K.A.B.'S REMEDY BY APPEAL AFTER JUDGMENT WOULD
BE INADEQUATE. FURTHER, THE TRIAL COURT HAS CERTIFIED ITS ORDER
FOR APPEAL. THEREFORE, R.K.H. AND K.A.B.'S MOTION TO ACCEPT
JURISDICTION OVER INTERLOCUTORY IS GRANTED, AND THIS COURT NOW
ACCEPTS JURISDICTION OF THIS APPEAL PURSUANT TO APPELLATE RULE
14(B).
2. THE COURT ALSO FINDS THAT THE VERIFIED PETITION FOR
LIMITED PRO HAC VICE ADMISSION FOR PATRICIA M. LOGUE COMPLIES
WITH INDIANA ADMISSION AND DISCIPLINE RULE 3, SECTION 2;
ACCORDINGLY, THE VERIFIED PETITION FOR LIMITED PRO HAC VICE
PETITION IN APPEAL I IS GRANTED. PATRICIA M. LOGUE IS ORDERED
TO FILE A NOTICE OF PRO HAC VICE ADMISSION WITH THE CLERK OF
THIS COURT IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 2(B) OF RULE 3 OF THE
INDIANA ADMISSION AND DISCIPLINE RULE, WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS
OF THE DATE OF THIS ORDER. ALL PLEADINGS FILED ON BEHALF OF
R.K.H. AND K.A.B. MUST BE SIGNED BY INDIANA COUNSEL AS WELL AS
PRO HAC VICE COUNSEL, AND INDIANA COUNSEL MUST BE PRESENT IN THE
COURTROOM IN THE EVENT THAT ORAL ARGUMENT IS HELD IN THIS CASE.
3. THE OFC'S VERIFIED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AND
REQUEST FOR CONSOLIDATION IS GRANTED, AND THE COURT CONSOLIDATES
APPEAL II INTO APPEAL I. THEREFORE, THE CLERK OF THE COURT IS
DIRECTED TO TRANSFER ALL DOCUMENTS FROM APPEAL II INTO APPEAL I
AND THEN CLOSE THE DOCKET FOR APPEAL II. ALL FUTURE PLEADINGS
SHALL BE FILED IN APPEAL I.
4. THE COURT SETS AN EXPEDITED SCHEDULE FOR THIS APPEAL. THE
MORGAN COUNTY CLERK SHALL FILE THE NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF
CLERK'S RECORD WITHIN TWENTY-FIVE (25) DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS
ORDER WITH NO ALLOWANCE FOR EXTENSIONS. IF ONE OR MORE HEARINGS
NEED TO BE TRANSCRIBED, THERE SHALL BE NO EXTENSION OF TIME TO
PREPARE THE TRANSCRIPT OR TRANSCRIPTS. FINALLY, BEYOND THE
EXTENSION GRANTED BY THIS ORDER, THERE SHALL BE NO EXTENSIONS TO

THE PARTIES TO PREPARE AND FILE THEIR BRIEFS.

5. THE CLERK OF THE COURT SHALL FILE A COPY OF THIS ORDER IN BOTH APPEAL I AND APPEAL II.

6. VICKIE KIVETT IS DIRECTED TO FILE A COPY OF THIS ORDER UNDER CAUSE NUMBER 55C01-0409-JC-179.
