ORDER

By order dated October 24, 2008, the Indiana Supreme Court has determined that “Jurisdiction, to the extent it lies in this appeal, lies with the Court of Appeals.” Consequently, all of the pleadings filed to date have been transferred to the Court of Appeals and are deemed to have been filed with the Court of Appeals.

This case has been assigned to a writing panel according to this Court’s standard predetermined case assignment procedures.

This Court has considered Appellants’ request for an expedited briefing schedule and both responses.

Having reviewed and considered the parties’ pleadings, the Court FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. For the purposes of this Order, “filing” means physically present in the Clerk’s Office by the ordered date and time.

2. Appellants’ Verified Motion to Establish Expedited Briefing Schedule is GRANTED, as follows:

a. All motions for temporary admission shall be filed no later than Monday, October 27, 2008, at 12:00 noon Indianapolis time.

b. The Notice of Completion of Transcript shall be filed no later than Tuesday, October 28, 2008 at 5:00 p.m. Indianapolis time. The Lake County Circuit and Superior Courts Clerk is ordered to transmit the transcript to the Clerk of this Court along with the Notice of Completion of Transcript.

c. The Appellant's Brief and Appendix shall be filed no later than Monday, October 27, 2008, at 12:00 noon Indianapolis time.

d. The Appellees' Briefs shall be filed no later than Wednesday, October 29, 2008, at 12:00 noon Indianapolis time.

e. No Reply Brief shall be permitted.

3. This matter is scheduled for Oral Argument for the following time, date, and place:

1:30 P.M., INDIANAPOLIS TIME
THURSDAY, OCTOBER 30, 2008

The Court hereby designates that Oral Argument will be held at the Indiana Supreme Court Courtroom, State House Room 317, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204.

Each side is allotted thirty minutes for argument.

4. No extensions of any deadline will be permitted.


